

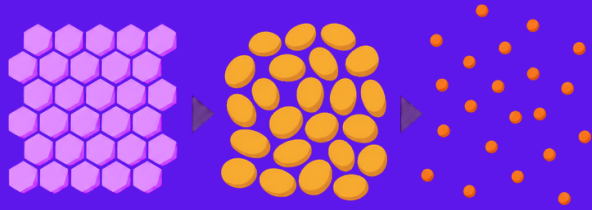

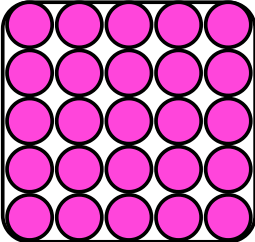
States of matter

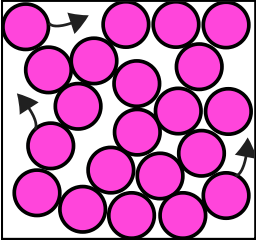
Material properties

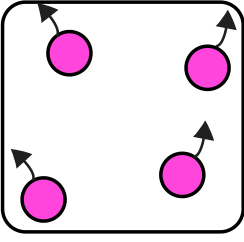


When matter is **solid**, molecules stay locked together in the same shape.

Label each picture solid, liquid, or gas.

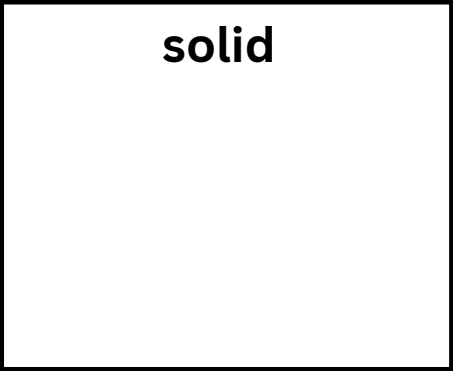




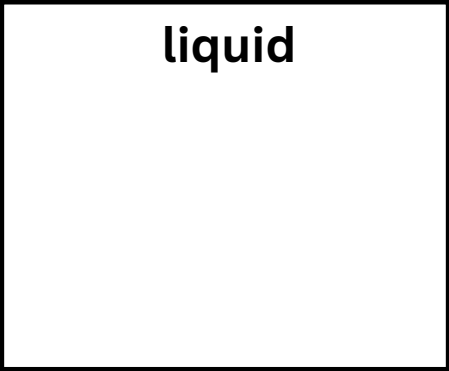


Draw one example of each state of matter.
